Mini-POSH needs wicker baskets for packaging auction gifts. No small baskets or seasonal colors please. Bring your baskets to the Development Office.

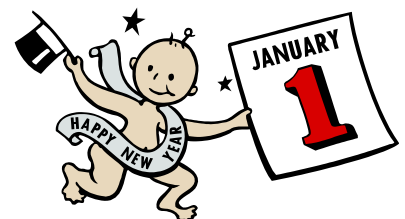
Large (shortest diameter greater than 16"):
