#### FAMILY SERVICE PLAN

The SFHS Family Service Program is a wonderful opportunity for parents to be involved in their student's high school experience.

Each family must provide 25 hours of service or equivalent of donated supplies to the school. Participation of less than 25 hours will be billed at a rate of \$18 per hour. Credit for donated supplies is given at a rate of \$12 for one hour. In the event that a family earns more than 25 hours in a school year, the excess up to 25 hours may be carried over to the following year.

Donations of cookies/brownies receive credit at a rate of 2 dozen for 1 service hour. These donations must be pre-approved by the Family Service Coordinator or chairperson.
