SUMMER CAMPS

Summer camps are open to St. Francis High School students only.

BASEBALL CAMP

This camp will be conducted by the Varsity Baseball Staff and is open to all students who are currently enrolled at St. Francis. The camp will include conditioning, weight training, and specific Baseball skills.

Monday through Thursday
11:45 a.m. - 1:15 p.m.

BASKETBALL CAMP

The St. Francis Basketball Program is offering a summer basketball class open to any incoming freshmen interested in improving their basketball skills. The first three weeks of the class will focus on the all important offensive skills of shooting, passing, dribbling, ball handling, body balance, and footwork. Basic offensive and defensive team concepts that are used in the St. Francis Basketball Program will also be taught during this time. The last two weeks of the class will revolve around intramural league play. The purpose of the intramural league play is to get the class participants to take the skills and concepts that have been taught during the first three weeks of the class and then use them in game conditions. The St. Francis Basketball staff will conduct all classes. All participants will receive a St. Francis Basketball T-shirt, and an improved confidence in their basketball skills.

DRUMLINE CAMP

This is an introduction to the different aspects of a drumline. The SF Drumline, begun in 2005, has performed at athletic events, local parades, and in the school's Festival of the Arts. Students will learn to read music, practice their development of cadence and be instructed in precision marching as well as other performance facets of Drumline. Recommended for returning drumline performers, the camp is also open to beginners. Instruments are provided.

FOOTBALL CAMP

This camp is conducted by the Varsity Football Staff, the camp is designed for any incoming Freshman who wishes to play Freshman football in 2009. The camp will include both weight room and on-field instruction, emphasizing St. Francis offensive and defensive terminology and techniques. The camp is scheduled so that students attending summer school may attend without missing any classroom opportunities. The St. Francis Football Staff feels that it is important to attend the camp; however, attendance is not mandatory and those not attending may still participate in the Fall. All camp participants will receive a t-shirt, shorts and a practice jersey.

SOCCER CAMP July 27–July 31

St. Francis Summer Soccer Camp is available only to students who are enrolled at St. Francis High School. The camp will include physical and skill work and assessment, small group and team tactics, and indoor and outdoor games. Camp will include fieldwork, classroom sessions (with film), and indoor games. The camp is conducted by the St. Francis Soccer staff and alumni and includes a t-shirt for participation.

TENNIS CAMP July 22–July 25

The St. Francis Tennis Program is offering a summer Tennis class open to any student enrolled at St. Francis High School and is interested in improving their Tennis skills. The class will be conducted by the Varsity Tennis Coach and will be held at Fremont Tennis Center, 600 W. Hahn, Glendale, CA.

WHO MAY ATTEND?

- ◆ Enrollment is co-ed and is open to students entering 7th through 12th grades (exceptions are noted).
- ◆ Students from other high schools should check the transfer credit guidelines with their guidance counselors PRIOR to enrolling in a course at St. Francis High School.
- ◆ Each class requires a minimum enrollment of 10 students.
- ◆ Students may enroll in up to four (4) courses.
- ◆ Enrollment is on a first-come, first serve basis.

PAYMENTS

- ◆ Payment in full is due at the time of registration.
- ◆ A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed on applications received after June 12.
- ◆ Registration for all Camps is SEPARATE.
- ◆ Please write SEPARATE checks for any of the Camps. Designate "Baseball", "Tennis", "Basketball", "Drumline", "Football", or "Soccer" Camp.

REFUNDS

- ◆ If a student withdraws in the first week, written notification from the parent is required. There is a 50% refund.
- ◆ No refunds will be given after the first week of classes.
- ◆ A full refund will be given for any class which is canceled due to insufficient enrollment.

SUMMER SCHOOL POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

- ◆ Students are expected to attend every class.
- ◆ Students who miss more than five (5) hours of instruction may not receive credit. Petitions for students to miss more than 5 hours must be filed with the Summer Session Director no later than June 12.
- ◆ A parent must report an absence as early as possible each day by calling (818) 790-0325. A student must bring a note on the day he/she returns.
- ◆ Failure to clear an absence may result in dismissal with no refund.
- ◆ St. Francis maintains a closed campus. Students may not leave campus between classes.

DRESS CODE

- ◆ Dress is casual in summer.
- ◆ Students may wear shorts, casual pants and t-shirts.
- ◆ Cut-off shorts or shirts, tank tops, inappropriate t-shirt insignia, thongs/sandals, gang-style or sloppy clothing are NOT acceptable. Student's mid section MUST be covered.
- ◆ Final decisions regarding attire rest with the Director.
More specific information will be sent with your schedule.

FOOD/BEVERAGES

- ◆ Students are encouraged to bring change for the vending machines.
- ◆ Food will be available from the food service.

REPORT CARDS / GRADE REPORTS

- ◆ Mid-session reports and final grades will be mailed home.
- ◆ Final grades will be mailed July 30 to other schools for students in the High School program who regularly attend other schools.*
- ◆ Junior High School grades will not be forwarded to schools unless a specific, written request is made.

*There is a \$5.00 fee for all transcript requests after August, 2009.

ADMISSION AFTER SUMMER SCHOOL

- ◆ Any student whose admission or readmission to St. Francis depends upon his Summer School performance will be notified after summer school ends regarding his admission status.

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

DRIVER'S EDUCATION # E4

This classroom course is designed to prepare students to become responsible drivers and to qualify for a learner's permit. **This is a Pass / Fail Only class.**

Quarter Credit Period 1

ADV. PLACEMENT HISTORY PREP COURSE #E7 (ONE WEEK SEMINAR JULY 6-10 ONLY)

This course will be a survey of the "nuts and bolts" of the AP European and AP U.S. History courses. It will include skills in critical thinking, vocabulary, essay questions, test construction, and document-based questions.

JUNIOR HIGH PROGRAM

The **JUNIOR HIGH PROGRAM** is offered for Pass / Fail Credit only. It is an enrichment program that improves the skills of students in essential academic areas. Entering 7th or 8th graders who want to improve their skills in a non-graded environment will benefit from our program.

ENGLISH REVIEW # JH1

This course is a summary of basic junior high English concepts, including grammar and writing, with emphasis on the individual needs of each student.

Quarter Course Periods 1, 2, or 3

MATH REVIEW # JH2

This course is a preparation in basic junior high math including fractions, percentages, and decimals, with emphasis on the individual needs of each student.

Quarter Course Period 3

PRE ALGEBRA # JH3

This course is a review of basic mathematical principles with an emphasis on the algebraic principles necessary for success in Algebra 1. Recommended for 8th graders with strong math skills.

Quarter Course Periods 1 or 2

PRE SPANISH # F6

This is an introductory course for those who have never taken Spanish. Open to 7th, 8th and 9th graders.

Quarter Course Periods 3 or 4

STUDY SKILLS FOR SUCCESS # JH4

In this course the student will learn organization, note-taking techniques, test-taking strategies, and the tools for effective listening.

Quarter Course Periods 2, 3, or 4

KEYBOARDING # F4

This is a self-paced, computer generated tutorial which teaches the basic typing and keyboard skills recommended for entering high school students. Taught in the St. Francis Computer Lab.

Quarter Course Periods 2 or 3

PHYSICAL EDUCATION # F7

This course guides students to run, to participate in field events, to lift weights, and to get in shape. Here is a great opportunity to get acquainted with their athletic abilities. Emphasis will be placed on developing physical confidence and stamina. Open to 7th - 12th graders.

Quarter Course Periods 3 or 4

ENTERING FRESHMAN PROGRAM

The **ENTERING FRESHMAN PROGRAM** is designed to help 9th graders prepare for success in high school. Class size is limited to twenty-five (25) students, and preference in enrollment is given to St. Francis students.

PRE-ALGEBRA # F1 PRE-LATIN # F5

(MATH Requirement)
This course is a review of basic mathematical principles needed for success in Algebra 1, including a review of fractions, decimals, basic computation, and percentages.

Quarter Course Periods 1, 2, or 3

This course is designed as an introductory class in Latin, focusing on elements of basic grammar and vocabulary. The aim is to improve students' understanding and mastery of fundamental knowledge in English language through a fun introduction to Latin. Open to 7th, 8th and 9th graders. **This is a Pass / Fail Only class.**

Quarter Course Period 3

STUDY SKILLS/ READING IMPROVEMENT # F2

(READING Requirement)

This course will assist students in goal-setting, note-taking, and test strategies, and prepare students to improve their reading comprehension. St. Francis Summer Reading books will be used.

Quarter Course Periods 1, 2, 3, or 4

PRE-SPANISH # F6

This is an introductory course for those who have never taken Spanish. Open to 7th, 8th and 9th graders. **This is a Pass / Fail Only class.**

Quarter Course Periods 3 or 4

WRITING FUNDAMENTALS # F3

(LANGUAGE Requirement)

Designed for students who require assistance in Language Fundamentals, this course will summarize grammatical concepts and assist students in developing their composition skills.

Quarter Course Periods 1, 2, 3, or 4

PHYSICAL EDUCATION # F7
